From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 457: The Word became flesh for us in order to save us by reconciling us with God, who 'loved us and sent his Son to be the expiations for our sins': 'the Father has sent his Son as the Saviour of the world', and 'he was revealed to take away sins'.

Paragraph 458: The Word became flesh so that thus we might know God's love: 'In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him'.

Paragraph 459: The Word became flesh to be our model of holiness: 'Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me'.

Paragraph 460: The Word became flesh to make us 'partakers of the divine nature'.

Paragraph 480: Jesus Christ is true God and true man, in the unity of his divine person; for this reason he is the one and only mediator between God and men.
