From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1925: The common good consists of three essential elements: respect for and promotion of the fundamental rights of the person; prosperity, or the development of the spiritual and temporal goods of society; the peace and security of the group and of its members.

Paragraph 1926: The dignity of the human person requires the pursuit of the common good.

Paragraph 1929: Social justice can be obtained only in respecting the transcendent dignity of man.

Paragraph 1939: The principle of solidarity, also articulated in terms of 'friendship' or 'social charity', is a direct demand of human and Christian brotherhood.
