From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 520: In all of his life Jesus presents himself as our model. He is 'the perfect man', who invites us to become his disciples and follow him.

Paragraph 521: Christ enables us to live in him all that he himself lived, and he lives it in us. 'By his Incarnation, he, the Son of God, has in a certain way united himself with each man'.

Paragraph 1084: 'Seated at the right hand of the Father' and pouring out the Holy Spirit on his Body which is the Church, Christ now acts through the sacraments he instituted to communicate his grace. The sacraments are perceptible signs (words and actions) accessible to our human nature.

Paragraph 2304: 'Peace is the tranquility of order'. Peace is the work of justice and the effect of charity.

Paragraph 2305: Earthly peace is the image and fruit of the peace of Christ, the messianic 'Prince of Peace'.
