From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 508: From among the descendants of Eve, God chose the Virgin Mary to be the mother of his Son. 'Full of grace', Mary is 'the most excellent fruit of redemption': from the first instant of her conception, she was totally preserved from the stain of original sin and she remained pure from all personal sin throughout her life.

Paragraph 509: Mary is truly 'Mother of God' since she is the mother of the eternal Son of God made man, who is God himself.

Paragraph 974: The Most Blessed Virgin Mary, when the course of her earthly life was completed, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven, where she already shares in the glory of her Son's Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of his Body.
