From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1253: Baptism is the sacrament of faith. But faith needs the community of believers. It is only within the faith of the Church that each of the faithful can believe. The faith required for baptism is not a perfect and mature faith, but a beginning that is called to develop. The catechumen or Godparent is asked: "What do you ask of God's Church?" The response is: 'Faith;'

Paragraph 1254: For all the baptised, children or adults, faith must grow after Baptism. For this reason the Church celebrates each year at the Easter Vigil the renewal of baptism promises. Preparation for Baptism leads only to the threshold of new life. Baptism is the source of that new life in Christ from which the entire Christian life springs forth.

Paragraph 772: It is in the Church that Christ fulfils and reveals his own mystery as the purpose of God's plan: 'to unite all things in him.'

Paragraph 776: The Church 'is the visible plan of God's love for humanity', because God desires 'that the whole human race may become one People of God, form one Body of Christ, and be built up into one temple of the Holy Spirit'.

Paragraph 780: The Church in this world is the sacrament of salvation, the sign and instrument of the communion of God and men.
