- ❖ Callington Honey Fair will be on Wednesday 5th October. It's worth a visit.
- ❖ Parish Diaries for 2017 will be available from next weekend: they are free.
- ❖ The Requiem Mass for Beryl Matthews RIP will be at Callington on Thursday 6th October at 2.00pm, followed by cremation at Bodmin. The family is small in number and would welcome support from parishioners.
- ❖ Also on 6th October: Churches Together in Launceston at 7pm in the Salvation Army Hall.
- ❖ From Geoff Provis: St Cuthbert Mayne St Vincent de Paul Society has been in existence for many years, but it is now in need of additional members. We are a lay organisation devoted to good works, visiting and helping those in need. The 'need' may be of various kinds. We also support financially two twinned SVP Conferences in India which, of course, is part of our Catholic ethos. The food basket in our church goes to a needy non-Catholic family locally and we support them with coal, logs and other material goods when appropriate. One meeting a month is held, usually lasting less than an hour. There has been recent interest from Callington. Parishioners from other countries resident here are very welcome. Anyone interested please speak to Fr. David or any SVP member.
