From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 524: When the Church celebrates the liturgy of Advent each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Saviour's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for his second coming.

Paragraph 1171: In the liturgical year the various aspects of the one Paschal mystery unfold. This is also the case with the cycle of feasts surrounding the mystery of the incarnation (Annunciation, Christmas, Epiphany). They commemorate the beginning of our salvation and communicate to us the first fruits of the Paschal mystery.

- ❖ Advent Quiet Day at Buckfast Abbey on Saturday 3rd December from 10am. See notices.
- ❖ Advent Day of Recollection at St Rita's Centre, Honiton on Saturday 10th December from 10.30am. See notices.
- ❖ No Mass on Tuesdays 22nd and 29th November owing to clergy meetings at Buckfast Abbey.
- ❖ Callington: Advent Sunday Praise on Sunday 27th November. This year the Catholic church will be hosting this annual event, which starts at 6.30pm. There will be a choir and the Service will take the form of Vespers (Evening Prayer). Please support this Churches Together Venture if you can. All are very welcome and there will be tea and cake afterwards.
- ❖ Bude: Nikki and Peter Ware are collecting Christmas treats and non-perishable larder items (e.g. nice teas/coffee; chutneys and jams; pasta and rice) for the Poor Clare nuns at Lynton. There will be a box at the back of the church to receive these, and of course the people of Launceston and Callington are invited to contribute too.
