From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 528: The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the East, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee.

Paragraph 2466: In Jesus Christ, the whole of God's truth has been made manifest. 'Full of grace and truth', he came as the 'light of the world', he is the truth.
