- ❖ I am pleased to announce that our parish has been awarded a grant of £1,889.00 from the Guild of Our Lady of Ransom, a charity that helps poorer parishes to keep in credit.
- ❖ The First Holy Communion groups meet this Sunday after Mass.
- ❖ For Sale: Diocesan Year Book 2017 at £3, my *Religious Heritage of North and East Cornwall* at £5. Six free Church Diaries still available.
- ❖ From 25th February, based at Buckfast Abbey: an online course of 18 months duration. A chance to deepen your knowledge of the Catholic Faith. An outline of the course is on the notice board.
- ❖ 18th-19th February: Bishop Mark will visit all our churches and preside and preach at all Masses. I have circulated some thoughts about this to the PPC and Finance Committee. Among other things, I should like to have an extended coffee time after all the Masses and a buffet lunch at Launceston where it will be possible to meet the Bishop socially. Individual meetings, preferably at Launceston, should be arranged with me in advance. Please let me know if you have any ideas or opinions about the programme. In the light of these, I will produce a timetable fairly soon.
- ❖ A Sunday Mass in the Extraordinary Form in Latin will be celebrated weekly from Sunday 29th January at St Edward's Church, Home Park Avenue, Peverell, Plymouth PL3 4PG at 11.30am. The Mass will normally be celebrated by Fr. Anthony Pillari, the chaplain at Lanherne Convent.
