From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- ❖ My 'Canonisation' on Friday 24th March: coach booked from Bude. See notice board for approximate timetable. Please sign list legibly as soon as possible. So far we have about twenty parishioners. £10 per head with reduction for families.
- ❖ Gift Aid: Last year the parish received £6,904.32 through the Gift Aid scheme. This is a very welcome addition to parish funds. Many thanks to all those who took part. Even small amounts make a big difference. If you are a taxpayer and would like to join the Gift Aid scheme please take a form from the back of the church or contact Alison in the Parish Office.
- ❖ Christian Unity Week 18th-25th January. Please keep praying that one day all Christians will be one in Christ. At Bude on Sunday 22nd January there will be lunch at 12.30pm and a Service at St Michael's, Budehaven at 2.30pm. Apologies for the short notice. I have only just found out about this event.
- ❖ At Holsworthy there will be a shared lunch at 1pm, also on 22nd January, at the 'Stable' Church Hall, Chilsworthy followed by a United Service at 2pm led by Revd. Martin Keenan.
- ❖ Callington: After consultation with our regular Mass attendees, I have arranged for a new floor to be installed in the hall area on 30th and 31st January. This will no doubt make our church more welcoming. Most of the cost will be covered by our recent grant.
- ❖ The 2017 Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place from 27th May to 2nd June. There is also to be a Youth Pilgrimage there at the same time. Ask me for booking forms.
- ❖ Renewal of Ministries: We need help urgently:
 - Money counters after Sunday Mass (Launceston)
 - Welcomers before Mass (Launceston)
 - Readers and leaders of Prayers of the Faithful (Launceston and Bude)
 - Someone to organise and galvanise some social activities aided by a small committee
- ❖ From 25th February, based at Buckfast Abbey: an online course of 18 months duration. A chance to deepen your knowledge of the Catholic Faith. An outline of the course is on the notice board.
- ❖ A Sunday Mass in the Extraordinary Form in Latin will be celebrated weekly from Sunday 29th January at St Edward's Church, Home Park Avenue, Peverell, Plymouth PL3 4PG at 11.30am. The Mass will normally be celebrated by Fr. Anthony Pillari, the chaplain at Lanherne Convent.
