From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1961: God, our Creator and Redeemer, chose Israel for himself to be his people and revealed his Law to them, thus preparing for the coming of Christ. The Law of Moses expresses many truths naturally accessible to reason.

Paragraph 1962: The Old Law is the first stage of revealed law. Its moral prescriptions are summed up in the Ten Commandments.

Paragraph 1964: The Old Law is a preparation for the Gospel.

Paragraph 1965: The New Law or the Law of the Gospel is the perfection here on earth of the divine law, natural and revealed. It is the work of Christ and is expressed particularly in the Sermon on the Mount.
