From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 194: The Apostles' Creed is so called because it is rightly considered to be a faithful summary of the apostles' faith. It is the ancient baptismal symbol of the Church of Rome. Its great authority arises from this fact: it is 'the Creed of the Roman Church, the See of Peter the first of the apostles, to which he brought the common faith'.

Paragraph 1227: The baptised have 'put on Christ.' Through the Holy Spirit, Baptism is a bath that purifies, justifies and sanctifies.

Paragraph 1228: St Augustine says of Baptism: 'The word is brought to the material element, and it becomes a sacrament.'
