From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 748: The Church has no other light than Christ's; according to a favourite image of the Church Fathers, the Church is like the moon, all its light reflected from the sun.

Paragraph 2466: In Jesus Christ the whole of God's truth has been made manifest. 'Full of grace and truth', he came as the 'light of the world', he is the Truth. 'Whoever believes in me may not remain in darkness.'

Paragraph 2470: The disciple of Christ consents to 'live in the truth', that is, in the simplicity of a life in conformity with the Lord's example, abiding in his truth.

Paragraph 2105: Christians are called to be the light of the world. Thus, the Church shows forth the kingship of Christ over all creation and in particular over human societies.
