From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 989: We firmly believe, and hence we hope that, just as Christ is truly risen from the dead and lives for ever, so after death the righteous will live for ever with the risen Christ and he will raise them up on the last day.

Paragraph 991: Belief in the resurrection of the dead has been an essential element of the Christian faith from its beginnings.

Paragraph 993: The Pharisees and many of the Lord's contemporaries hoped for the resurrection.

Paragraph 996: From the beginning, Christian faith in the resurrection has met with incomprehension and opposition. 'On no point does the Christian faith encounter more opposition than on the resurrection of the body.'

Paragraph 997: What is rising? In death, the separation of the soul from the body, the human body decays and the soul goes to meet God, while awaiting its reunion with its glorified body.
