From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 559: How will Jerusalem welcome her Messiah? Although Jesus had always refused popular attempts to make him king, he chooses the time and prepares the details for his messianic entry into the city of 'his father David'. Acclaimed as son of David, as the one who brings salvation (*Hosanna* means 'Save!' or 'Give salvation!'), the 'King of glory' enters his City 'riding on an ass'.

Paragraph 560: Jesus' entry into Jerusalem manifested the coming of the kingdom that the King-Messiah was going to accomplish by the Passover of his Death and Resurrection. It is with the celebration of that entry on Palm Sunday that the Church's liturgy solemnly opens Holy Week.
