From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- ❖ The Fatima Apostolate’s Pilgrim Virgin statue will be crowned by Bishop Mark in the Cathedral on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> June and the Diocese consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The statue is accompanied by relics for veneration of Francisco and Jacinta, who will be canonised as the first child saints by Pope Francis at Fatima on 13<sup>th</sup> May.
