From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 659: 'So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God.' Christ's body was glorified at the moment of his Resurrection, as proved by the new and supernatural powers it subsequently and permanently enjoys. But during the forty days when he eats and drinks familiarly with his disciples and teaches them about the kingdom, his glory remains veiled under the appearance of ordinary humanity. Jesus' final apparition ends with the irreversible entry of his humanity into divine glory, symbolised by the cloud and by heaven, where he is seated from that time forward at God's right hand.
