From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 215: God is Truth itself, whose words cannot deceive. This is why one can abandon oneself in full trust to the truth and faithfulness of his word in all things. - ❖ First Holy Communion Classes for children aged 7 or 8 begin on Sunday 8th October after the Youth Mass. Date of the Mass of First Holy Communion: 20th May 2018 – Pentecost Sunday. If numbers are large, I will have to use other Sundays too. Registration forms available from me.
- ❖ Enquirers' Day for Deacons: ask me for information and advice. I could make very good use of a deacon or two in this huge parish: Saturday 14th October at St Boniface House.
- ❖ Annual Harvest Supper at Callington on Sunday 8th October after the evening Mass. List now open for booking tickets.
- ❖ SVP: The local SVP sponsors two twinned Indian SVP Conferences, costing £300 per year. Parishioners may wish to sponsor a twin on a personal basis or the Indian Student Scheme, details of which are as follows: Higher Education Scheme: £120 per year; Technical and Vocational Training Scheme: £70 per year; Vidya Jyothi Scheme: £15 per year. The latter is designed to keep children at school to receive a basic education. Further details may be obtained from the local SVP.
- ❖ I have left prayer cards in all our churches. Please take them and use them to pray for priestly vocations as a follow-up to our recent 40 Hour Devotion and Pilgrimage.
