From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 2254: Public authority is obliged to respect the fundamental rights of the human person and the conditions for the exercise of his freedom.

Paragraph 2256: Citizens are obliged in conscience not to follow the directives of civil authorities when they are contrary to the demands of the moral order. 'We must obey God rather than men'

Paragraph 1925: The common good consists of three essential elements: respect for and promotion of the fundamental rights of the person; prosperity, or the development of the spiritual and temporal goods of society; the peace and security of the group and of its members.
