- ❖ Launceston: the high altar candles are being refurbished two at a time by Jonathan Williams. They have not been stolen.
- ❖ Callington: organist Kevin Grant is taking a break. We are fortunate that an organist from Plymouth will supply for us.
- ❖ Callington: work on improvements to the sacristy and kitchen and a new confessional have now begun.
- ❖ Operation Christmas Child: fill a shoe box with goodies for children who are victims of war, famine, disease, etc. If you would like to help, please ask Deborah Lewis at Callington for a leaflet.
- ❖ Mass Count for 22nd October: Bude 55, Launceston 88, Callington 48. Total 191. The average for October is 187. Last year it was 216.
