- ❖ November is the Month of the Holy Souls. We pray for our departed loved ones. We also pray for the 'forgotten dead' – those who have no one to pray for them.
- ❖ Monday 6th November at 6pm, St Peter's Church, Holsworthy: Installation of Revd. Elizabeth Burke as Priest in Charge of Holsworthy and surrounding churches. I shall be there to represent our parish.
- ❖ Thursday 9th November at noon in Plymouth Cathedral: Requiem Mass for deceased clergy of our Diocese. You are welcome to attend.
- ❖ Friday 10th November at Bude at noon: Funeral Mass for Mike Willis, followed by cremation at Bodmin. Fr. Kevin O'Connell will be the chief Celebrant.
- ❖ Sunday 12th November at Launceston: Remembrance Day Mass, two minutes silence, and visit to our churchyard, weather permitting.
- ❖ Saturday 18th November, 10.30am – 3.00pm at St Austell Catholic Church: Autumn Fayre. Crafts, Christmas presents, refreshments.
- ❖ Sunday 19th November: Youth Mass at Launceston. Please note this later date. After the Mass there will be a meeting of the First Holy Communion group.
- ❖ Tuesday 28th November at 6pm in Plymouth Cathedral: Solemn Vespers of St Cuthbert Mayne with Cardinal Vincent Nichols, Archbishop of Westminster, and veneration of the relic.
- ❖ Wednesday 29th November at 12.05pm at Buckfast Abbey. Solemn Mass of our Patron Saint's Feast Day, and veneration of the relic, preceded by a talk to the diocesan clergy by Cardinal Vincent, who will also preside at the Mass. These events will replace our parish celebrations. You are all very welcome to come to the Vespers and Mass.
- ❖ Launceston and Callington: I should like to replace the usual Communion hymn with quiet music. I asked for your views and so far all are favourable. But please speak your mind.
- ❖ Operation Christmas Child: fill a shoe box with goodies for children who are victims of war, famine, disease, etc. If you would like to help, please ask Deborah Lewis at Callington for a leaflet.
- ❖ The 2018 Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes will be in early August rather than May. See poster. The Youth Pilgrimage is at the same time.
