From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

 - No Gloria, no flowers, Sanctus and Agnus Dei in Latin.
 - New Parish Mass Books: a huge improvement on what we have been using.
 - Bude: Sung Preface and Eucharistic acclamation. I'll explain later.
 - Parish: Prayer cards for priestly vocations. Please use them during the Holy Communion quiet time.

- ❖ Christmas Service times now available. See yellow notice. Because the Mass times are very close together this year, I should welcome extra help with welcoming, reading and serving.
- ❖ Advent Walk with Me: 100 copies are now available. Good spiritual preparation for Christmas. And they are free!

Solemn Mass of our Patron Saint's Feast Day, and veneration of the relic, preceded by a talk to the diocesan clergy by Cardinal Vincent, who will also preside at the Mass.
