From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 144: To obey (from the Latin *ob-audire*, to 'hear or listen to') in faith is to freely submit to the word that has been heard, because its truth is guaranteed by God, who is truth itself. Abraham is the model of such obedience offered to us by Sacred Scripture. The Virgin Mary is its most perfect embodiment.

Paragraph 59: In order to gather together scattered humanity God calls Abram from his country, his kindred and his father's house, and makes him Abraham, that is, 'the father of a multitude of nations'. 'In you all the nations of the earth shall be blessed.'

Paragraph 154: Believing is possible only by grace and the interior helps of the Holy Spirit. But it is no less true that believing is an authentically human act. Trusting in God and cleaving to the truths he has revealed is contrary neither to human freedom nor to human reason.
