From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 652: Christ's Resurrection is the fulfilment of the promises both of the Old Testament and of Jesus himself during his earthly life. The phrase 'in accordance with the Scriptures' indicates that Christ's Resurrection fulfilled these predictions.

Paragraph 656: Faith in the Resurrection has as its object an event which is historically attested to by the disciples, who really encountered the Risen One. At the same time, this event is mysteriously transcendent insofar as it is the entry of Christ's humanity into the glory of God.

Paragraph 657: The empty tomb and the linen cloths lying there signify in themselves that by God's power Christ's body had escaped the bonds of death and corruption. They prepared the disciples to encounter the Risen Lord.

Paragraph 658: Christ, 'the first-born from the dead', is the principle of our own resurrection, even now by the justification of our souls and one day by the new life he will impart to our bodies.
