From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- Paragraph 2754: The principal difficulties in the practice of prayer are distraction and dryness. The remedy lies in faith, conversion, and vigilance of heart.
- Paragraph 2755: Two frequent temptations threaten prayer: lack of faith, and acedia – a form of depression stemming from lax ascetical practice that leads to discouragement.
- Paragraph 2757: ‘Pray constantly.’ It is always possible to pray. It is even a vital necessity. Prayer and Christian life are inseparable.
- Paragraph 2746: When ‘his hour’ came, Jesus prayed to the Father. His prayer, the longest transmitted by the Gospel, embraces the whole economy of creation and salvation, as well as his death and Resurrection.
- Paragraph 2747: Christian tradition rightly calls this prayer the ‘priestly’ prayer of Jesus.
- Paragraph 2749: Jesus fulfilled the work of the Father completely; his prayer, like his sacrifice, extends until the end of time.
