From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 2746: When 'his hour came', Jesus prayed to the Father.

Paragraph 2747: Christian tradition rightly calls this prayer the 'priestly' prayer of Jesus. It is the prayer of our high priest, inseparable from his sacrifice, from his passing over (Passover) to the Father to whom he is wholly consecrated'.

Paragraph 2748: In this Paschal and sacrificial prayer, everything is recapitulated in Christ: God and the world; the Word and the flesh; eternal life and time; the love that hands itself over and the sin that betrays it; the disciples present and those who will believe in him by their word; humiliation and glory. It is the prayer of unity.

Paragraph 2749: Jesus fulfilled the work of the Father completely; his prayer, like his sacrifice, extends until the end of time.
