From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 237: The Trinity is a mystery of faith in the strict sense, one of the 'mysteries that are hidden in God, which can never be known unless they are revealed by God':

Paragraph 265: By the grace of Baptism 'in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit', we are called to share in the life of the Blessed Trinity, here on earth in the obscurity of faith, and after death in eternal light.

- ❖ There will be a retiring collection on Corpus Christi Sunday for the Plymouth Secular Clergy Fund. This is an annual collection for sick and retired parish priests in this Diocese. You have a chance to show your gratitude to the priests who have served you.
- ❖ Buckfast Abbey Millennium Celebrations 1018-2018. Lots going on: food, music, vocations, etc. Programme available here.
- ❖ Launceston: the regular meetings with Deacon Richard will continue every FIRST and THIRD Thursday at 6pm in the Presbytery. The group will look at the Readings for Sunday Mass. You are very welcome to join us.
- ❖ Launceston: Congratulations to Altar Servers Joe Lopez and Angeline and Gladys Toledo on being admitted to the Guild of St Stephen. They now wear the Guild Medal as a mark of their five years of faithful service. I am always keen to welcome new recruits to serve on the altar, so please volunteer if interested.
- ❖ Callington: New flooring for the renovated kitchen, sacristy and confessionals has now been put in place. I hope to bless this work soon.
- ❖ Callington: Congratulations to PPC Chair Val Williams and Bernard, who celebrate 55 years of marriage. I shall present them with signed Mass cards from each of our communities.
- ❖ New Mass Books for Year B Part 2 are now available.

- ❖ Bude: A special collection has been made for Fr Kevin O'Connell, who celebrated his 40th Anniversary of priestly ordination last Maundy Thursday.
