From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- Paragraph 355: God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him, male and female he created them.
- Paragraph 356: Of all visible creatures only man is 'able to know and love his creator'
- Paragraph 357: Being in the image of God the human individual possesses the dignity of a person, who is not just something, but someone.
- Paragraph 385: God is infinitely good and all his works are good. Yet no one can escape the experience of suffering or the evils in nature which seem to be linked to the limitations proper to creatures: and above all to the question of moral evil.
- Paragraph 390: The account of the fall in Genesis 3 uses figurative language, but affirms a primeval event, a deed that took place at the beginning of the history of man. Revelation gives us the certainty of faith that the whole human history is marked by the original fault freely committed by our first parents.
