From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- Paragraph 1414: As sacrifice, the Eucharist is also offered in reparation for the sins of the living and dead, and to obtain spiritual or temporal benefits from God.
- Paragraph 1415: Anyone who desires to receive Christ in Eucharistic communion must be in a state of grace. Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of Penance.
- Paragraph 1416: Communion with the Body and Blood of Christ increases the communicant's union with the Lord, forgives his venial sins and preserves him from grave sins.
- Paragraph 1418: Because Christ himself is present in the sacrament of the altar, he is to be honoured with the worship of adoration.
