### **KEEP ADVENT HOLY: 5 Suggestions**

1. Read/Reflect – you could use Advent Extra, a daily devotion book or an online resource, to feed your inner self.
2. Get some quiet time: there is half day of recollection at St Cuthbert Mayne Church/Hall on 8<sup>th</sup> December. Details in newsletter. Or book in to Advent Retreat at Honiton or find some time of quiet prayer at home. These things need to be planned and booked in your diary, otherwise they probably won't happen.
3. Remove the things that hinder you from receiving Christ with joy. Plan a time to celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation during Advent.
4. Create an Advent Wreath for your home, and light another candle each week. Buy a Christian Advent calendar, and a Christmas Crib, if you haven't already got one. You are invited to bring your cribs to Mass on 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent when they will be blessed.
5. Buy and send Religious Christmas cards with Christian stamps.
