## Cafod Living Simply in Bude

We, in Bude, decided to start by looking at how we could live more sustainably with creation. Being close to the sea and beaches, that seemed a good place to start. We contacted the 2 Minute Foundation. They aim to have 2 minutes of "Positivity" - finding simple little things, every day, to do good for ourselves and the planet.

These aims fit in well with ours. They run Bespoke Beach Sessions at the Crab Shack on Crooklets Beach in Bude and were happy to arrange one for us.

It is now arranged for us to have a session on **Thursday 18th July at 2pm** in the afternoon. We will be based at the Crab Shack which is behind the toilets on Crooklets Beach. The session will take about one hour and 30 minutes. It will include some beach cleaning, perhaps a little walk through the rockpools for those who are keen and maybe, if time, we might be able to watch nesting fulmars or dolphins cruising by!

If anyone is interested in joining us they would be most welcome, there will be a sign-up sheet in each church this weekend. We have booked in for a group of 20. If more wish to come then I would need to find out if an extra guide could be put on well in advance! I need to let them know numbers on Monday 15th July. It should be a very worthwhile event.
