Sacrament of Penance in Advent

Fr John will be available for confession before all Masses during the season of Advent.

Our advent preparation, to remove the things that hinder us from receiving Christ with joy, should include a sacramental confession. Plan ahead and arrange to go in this Parish or elsewhere.

Advent Sessions:

Launceston: The Chosen is a TV series that portrays the life and ministry of Jesus Christ, focusing on the personal stories of the people He interacted with. It offers a fresh, perspective on the Gospels, exploring the impact of Jesus on His followers. **We are showing an episode each week during Advent in the Charles Langdon Hall at St Cuthbert Mayne on Thursdays starting at 7.00pm. The first showing will be on Thursday 5th December. Each episode lasts for an hour, then there will be an opportunity for half hour sharing our thoughts.**

Bude: Fr Kevin will be leading **three sessions on the Lord's Prayer after Mass on Wednesday, December 4; Wednesday, December 11th and Wednesday, December 18th.**

Callington: **Lectio Divina, Reflecting on the Scriptures**, after Friday Masses at Our Lady of Victories during Advent. First session on Friday 6th December.
